



Announcing the Climate Change Agents Summer Camp 2022 Theme: From Concern to Conviction

The Climate Change Agent Camp challenges young leaders to prepare for the significant roles they will play in creating an equitable future for all as we face the complex climate change challenges of the present and future.

The camp offers opportunities for service learning and exploration of potential career paths and current community action. It brings life skills, academics and the arts to bear to ensure climate justice and approaches to climate impacts. The character strengths, collaboration skills and creativity applied at camp are designed to help a new generation serve the local and global community, brainstorming new ideas and forging new friendships while enjoying camp camaraderie. Indoor and outdoor activities include service-learning field trips.

The sponsors, Nevada County Climate Action Now and Full-Circle Learning, with additional support from Sierra Foothills Audubon, Nevada City Retreats and other donors, are pleased to present this leadership institute, available to middle and high school students. Acceptances are restricted due to limited space. Each scholarship application must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation form from a teacher or school administrator. The 2022 camp will extend from **Tuesday morning, July 19 through 1:00 pm, Saturday, July 23rd** at Nevada City Retreats on Lake Vera Purdon Road (with pick-up at the farmers market that day). These four nights and five days promise:

Climate Change Agents Camp 2022

Scholarship Application Requirements

1. **Teacher Recommendation:** A recommendation from a teacher regarding evidence of character, service, and either academic merit or potential or merit/potential in visual arts or musical arts or dance. Each reference should also comment on the student's specific character traits with an indication of any financial or other need that would influence the application process
2. **Student Commitments:** A paragraph from the student explaining why they would like to attend, ensuring they will commit to the code of ethics required at the camp and will be available during the dates of camp, both during the day and the overnight portions of camp
3. **Health and Parent Release Forms:** A parent release form filed with the application, also listing any medical issues and allergies or dietary restrictions, with a statement that the student will obtain a negative PCR test for Covid-19 test within 72 hours of attendance at camp and will obtain the vaccine and submit a copy of the vaccination with the application. (The student will advise the camp committee if any family member tests positive with Covid-19 and is still recovering within one week of the Camp start-date. The camp reserves the right to postpone or cancel camp based on the emergence of a variant or increasing coronavirus cases among campers or in the community in the weeks leading up to camp, in compliance with suggested county public health guidelines.)
4. **Important Dates:** Applications must be received via email or postal mail before May 20, 2022. Scholarship notifications will be reported via email and postal mail by June 20, 2022. Parents bring students to camp drop-off site July 19, 2022.

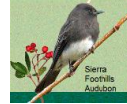
