Scholarship decisions are based on character, merit (academic or visual/musical/performing arts) and financial need. **Scholarship recipients will be notified by June 1.**

When and Where: Drop off at Pioneer Park tennis courts, 8:00 am, Tuesday July 18. Pick up: Nevada City farmers' market on Saturday, July 22. These four nights and five days will bring:

2. ___ **A brief paragraph** from the student explaining why they would like to participate and ensuring they will commit to the code of ethics and will be available, both during the daytime and the overnight portions of the retreat.
3. ___ **A parent release form**, filed with the application, also listing medical issues and food or other allergies, with a statement that the student will obtain a negative Covid-19 test within three days of attendance at camp and. The student will advise the camp committee if any family member tests positive with Covid-19 or is still recovering from Covid-19 within ten days of the retreat..
4. ___ **Application submission** online or by mail: Before May 15. Notifications will be made by June 1.
